

Advice on trying the Toilet Paper Pinterest Craft

This is an easy craft project to do with all ages of kids or as an adult. The supplies can be found around the house and you can make it fancier with nicer paper, canvas and calligraphy. You can also just use supplies around the house.

Time: about 30 minutes

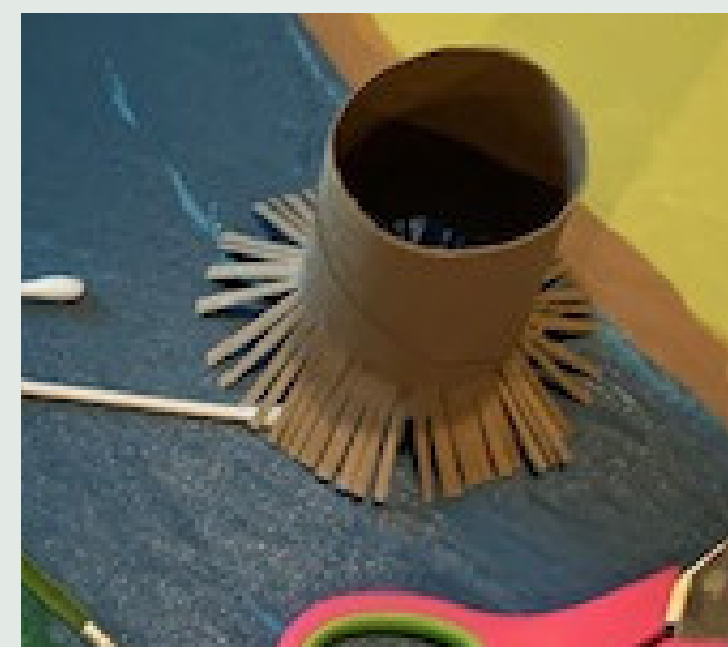
Supplies

Toilet Paper Roll
Scissors
Paint
Paper or Canvas
Paper plate
Q Tips
Cottonballs or washcloth



1 Cut TP Roll

Use scissors to cut slits about 1" from the top of the TP roll. Do this around the whole roll. Then flair it out. Kids can help with this part. My toddlers did a few cuts with kids scissors.



2 Use the toilet roll like a stamp

Spread the paint on the paper plate. Stamp the paper with the toilet paper roll. You can rotate the TP roll on the paper for a more fuzzy look.

3 Add Details

Use the Q-Tips to draw on stems. Spread out the cotton balls and stamp for details



4 Let Dry

Give it time to dry



6 Finished!

I think my son's turned out the best (the black one). He was not trying to be exact like I was and I think the finished product looked great! We're going to add a message using white paint later.



5 Add a message

This is where the kids can be creative and write words, saint quotes or scripture
