# Activities

## PICK WHICH ONES WORK FOR YOUR FAMILY

- Listen to the Canticle of the Sun
- Read the Tiny Seed by Eric Carle or Watch Story on Youtube
- Read the Parable of the mustard seed Mathew 13:31-32 and talk about the following questions.
  - How is the mustard seed in the parable like the tiny seed in the first story?
  - How is your faith like the tiny seed?
  - What are some things you can do to nurture your tiny seed (of faith)?
- Germinate Seeds
  - Wet paper towel and place in zip lock bag with bean or pea seed.
  - Tape zip lock bag to a sunny window
  - Check on your seed daily to watch for growth. Help them use descriptive words for observations. Older kids can map the seeds growth over time on a chart.

- Walk around your yard looking for signs of spring
- Draw a picture and write about what you learned about seeds and the wonder of creation
